I undertake medico-legal work in the form of clinical negligence claims including Standard of Care, Delay in Diagnosis, Causation, Tumour Doubling, Condition and Prognosis, relating to breast cancer and breast surgery • I have 30 years' experience of writing over 2000 medicolegal reports since 1992 • I write reports to the courts for both Claimants and Defendants • I produce approximately 60 reports per year, at a 60:40 claimant/defendant ratio • I give evidence in court approximately once a year as an Expert Witness • Reports take two to three months to prepare upon receipt of all relevant documentation to the case.
